Now that monsoons have started cooling down the heat a bit, many of us are looking for inspiration for our next crafty venture. Look no further, for we have some amazing pattern suggestions and some great products for you, as always!

Tunisian Crochet, also known as Afghan Crochet, uses a long crochet hook, resembling a knitting needle, with a hook at one end and a stopper at the other end. Such hooks are called Afghan hooks or Tunisian hooks. Tunisian crochet is often considered a mix of crochet and knitting, since some knitting techniques, like intarsia, are also used in Tunisian crochet.

The fabric created by Tunisian crochet is slightly less elastic than normal crochet and substantially thicker. It is slightly faster to create fabric by Tunisian than normal crochet, and approximately twice the speed of knitting. The tension of the yarn is much looser than in standard crochet or knitting.

At AllKraftz, we offer straight, double ended and interchangeable Tunisian hooks, to cater for all types of Tunisian crochet.

Featured free patterns for Tunisian Crochet



Pax is a simple yet amazingly beautiful narrow shawl made in Tunisian Crochet. Written in simple language, it is one of the most Popular Tunisian patterns on Ravelry. An excellent first project for all who want to try Tunisian crochet, this shawl can be made by a simple crochet hook and doesn't require a traditional Afghan hook. Try this shawl with our amazingly soft yarn [Diva](#) with a size 6mm [Symfonie](#) crochet hook.



Another great first project for Tunisian enthusiasts, this pot holder can be made with one skein of yarn. The pot holder uses the basic tunisian techniques, is made as a rectangle and doubled before making the edging. Try out this pot holder with our 100% cotton yarn [Bella](#) and a size 4mm [Tunisian crochet hook](#).



This is a simple scarf pattern with an easy 4 stitch, 1 row (including the return row) repeat. Both the width and length can be easily adapted to suit your personal need/taste. You can make this scarf in any yarn that you have, and wouldn't require more than a skein. Try this scarf with our beautiful yarn [Happy Baby](#) and a size 6mm Tunisian Crochet Hook.

Featured Tunisian Hooks



Spectra Afghan hooks are made from superior quality acrylic material in a stunning deep pink color. These lightweight hooks are excellent for beginners and kids, as well as for experienced crafters looking for a lightweight, smooth surface.

The Symfonie interchangeable hooks are made of densified laminated Birchwood with metal ferrules on one end, where a cable can be screwed to make the hook into an Afghan hook. This set is an all-in-one which caters to all your crochet needs. Use the individual hooks as single ended crochet hooks, or connect a cable with an end cap to make an Afghan hook, you can even connect two hooks on either ends to make a double ended Afghan crochet hook.



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
